



Mini Cakes for Meals On Wheels by Iris Boxsell & Lyne Fuller

The relationship between Sydney Branch and Lions Club of Hornsby began when Mum asked if they'd donate a few of their cakes to supplement the ones donated by our members. Originally, the intention was for the cakes to be distributed to

elderly people who were alone at Christmas to help brighten their day.

In the beginning, the Lions Club donated a couple of boxes and a few members came together to decorate them. After a few years, the "Lions Club Christmas Cake person" changed and the new person offered to

donate enough cakes for all recipients of the Meals On Wheels food. Hence our now regular working bee of anywhere from 120 to 200 cakes this year!

Mum started decorating the mini fruit cakes for Hornsby & Ku-ring-gai Meals On Wheels back in 1985. 35 years later, the tradition lives on!

In November, Mum and I, together with Erin Fuller, Mum's carer Vicki Mills, Belinda Eleter, little Elahni Eleter, Helen Barton, Jennie Kenyon, Paulette Blackman, Barbara Newton, Margaret Tesoriero and Mary Anne Loveridge spent two days covering and decorating mini cakes The Lions Club donated 200 cakes and Jan

Sambrook, Annu Mishra and **Helen Barton** together produced an additional 58 pieces.

Decorated plaques were provided by **Elizabeth Ivory**, Annu Mishra & Vicki Mills **Jan Boon**, **Mary Anne Loveridge** and the **Juniors**. It was hard going but so much fun to catch up with fellow decorators after all the social isolation we had to endure during the year. At the end of Day Two,
